Enrollment Priority

Due to the limited number of children Winnetka Public School Nursery (WPSN) is able to accept, WPSN has established the following guidelines to enroll students in a manner that provides reasonable balance between the sexes. WPSN also reserves the right to cancel or reschedule a class due to insufficient enrollment.

1. Current Student

Students who are attending WPSN during the 2009-2010 school year will be offered placements based on the total number of years the child and siblings have attended WPSN.

2. Sibling of Current Student or Former Student

Siblings of students who are attending WPSN during the 2009-2010 school year and those who formerly attended WPSN will be offered placements based on the total number of years siblings have attended WPSN.

3. New Student

New Family Applications will be accepted beginning June 15th of the calendar year prior to entry. All New Family Applications will be kept on file until the conclusion of Returning Family Registration, at which time New Families will be offered places in order of date/time of completed applications. Placement is subject to availability and at the discretion of the Director.

WPSN will offer placements for the 2010-11 school year beginning in the fall of 2009. In accordance with procedures adopted by members of the Winnetka Alliance for Early Childhood, WPSN will not require a tuition payment to secure an offered placement until Friday, January 29, 2010.

Lotteries will be held within priority categories wherever there are more requests than places available.
